We are pleased to announce that Brookstone Golf Course will open Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>. Due to the Stay at Home 2.0 order, there will be changes to our operation at the start of the season. Please take the time to read below, as we ask for your cooperation.

We are currently only able to permit play for New Hampshire residents and Members. For membership info, [click here](#).

Please maintain six feet of social distancing between yourself, staff, other guests, and your playing partners.

Please follow all instructions and signage before, during, and after your round.

### **TEE TIMES**

Tee time intervals will be 15 minutes apart. **Tee times will be available in the next few days.** We are working hard to offer pre-paid online tee times and cart rentals, so stay tuned.

### **GOLF SHOP**

Please note that the Golf Shop will be **CLOSED** until further notice.

### **CHECK-IN PROCESS**

Upon arriving at Brookstone, please enter via the main entrance and drive straight up to check-in for your tee time at the first building on your right (the Fountain Room entrance). A Brookstone team member will be waiting under the awning to check you in. Once checked in, you should pull over to the parking lot to the left and remain in your vehicle until 15 minutes prior to your tee time. A staff member will direct you to your golf cart when your tee time is called. Once notified by the attendant, walkers must proceed to the first tee.

### **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

Our new 10th Hole will only be open for call ahead pre-paid take out service for before or after your round. **Menus will be available at check-in and at the 8th hole, so you can easily call to order food and drinks.** Online orders will also be available. A hospitality cart will be available, weather permitting, on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 10am until the slow of business.

### **GOLF CARTS**

Pull carts will be available on May 11<sup>th</sup>, but riding golf carts will NOT be available until Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. When using a riding cart, single riders ONLY are allowed on golf carts, unless you reside in the same home. Each golf cart will be cleaned and sanitized between uses. Due to the limited amount of golf carts available, they will be issued on a first come, first serve basis.

### **GOLF PROCEDURES**

Scorecards, pencils, water coolers, rakes, and other common items will not be available to start. Please plan accordingly. To keep score, [download a scorecard here](#). When you hit a ball in a bunker, you will be permitted to smooth and drop from knee height. Cups will have a liner to prevent a ball from going to the

bottom of a hole. Do not touch the flagstick. When you finish your round, you will be asked to leave your golf cart in a marked position and transport your equipment to your vehicle. Please leave the property upon completion of your round and remember to maintain six feet of social distancing between yourself, staff, other guests, and your playing partners.

### **GOLF CLUBS**

Personal clubs must be used. No rental sets or sharing of clubs is permitted.

### **LEAGUES & CAMPS**

League play is permitted to begin on Wednesday, May 20<sup>th</sup> and must follow appropriate tee time intervals and social distancing guidelines. Camps, Clinics and organized activities are suspended until further notice.

### **OTHER FACILITIES**

The target range, practice area, mini golf, and event center will be CLOSED to the public to start the season. Restrooms in the Golf Shop will be open. Please follow signage and enter on the side of the building.

As we continue to monitor this extremely fluid situation, we wish to Thank you for your cooperation, flexibility, and patience during these unprecedented times as we provide a safe and healthy environment for all our members, guests, and staff.
